

1st Annual Boggy Bayou Barbeque Cook Off



Accept entries until the day of the event.

1. BBQ Categories and Rules: There will be three (3) categories judged in two (2) divisions: Pork Spare Ribs, Chicken and Brisket in Professional divisions. To qualify for Grand Champion in either division, all three (3) categories must be entered by a team. All cooking must be done on site. Meat must be kept at 38 degrees or lower prior to cooking. Judging will commence at approximately 11 am.

2. Judging Categories will be judged on the basis of:

- 1) Appearance 2) Texture 3) Taste

Each team must provide enough BBQ for all judges.

Judging will commence at the following times: prizes include both trophies and cash

- 11 am Peoples Choice (Pork Butt and Pans will be provided)
- 12 pm Chicken
- 1 pm Pork Spare Ribs
- 2 pm Brisket

3. Set-up time: Each team is required to supply its own equipment for the Boggy Bayou Barbeque Cook Off. Professional Division Competitors must comply with IBCA cooking regulations. See www.ibcabbq.org for a complete list. Open flame pits or primitive fires are not allowed. Teams are allowed to set-up on Friday May 7th after 7am, as security will be provided. All set-ups must be completed no later than 8:30am Saturday May 8th. No vehicles will be allowed near the cooking spaces between 8:30am and 4:30pm Saturday May 8th. Team equipment and decorations must fit within the area assigned. A fire extinguisher must be supplied by each team. Each team is required to have sanitizers for hands and equipment available onsite. 4. Behavior & Conduct: This is a community event. Any negative or unruly conduct will be cause for removal from the event grounds.

5. Housekeeping: Each team will be expected to police their space and surrounding area for trash. Trash cans will be supplied but we strongly suggest bringing extra trash liners for the event.

6. Clean-up/breakdown: All teams are responsible for the clean-up and break-down of any and all props, decorations, cooking utensils, equipment and trash in and around their space. Any property left at the event after 6pm will be considered trash and thrown away.

Any violation of any of the aforementioned rules will be grounds for disqualification and dismissal from the event. The City of Niceville and/or the Boggy Bayou Barbeque Cook - Off Committee and any volunteers will not be held responsible for any accidents(s), theft, or damage to person (s) and/or equipment.
