

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

City of Niceville, Florida

Separate sealed bids for the construction of A New Wastewater Pump Station at City Hall will be received by the City of Niceville, Florida in the City Council Chambers at 208 North Partin Drive, Niceville, Florida, 32578 until 2:00 p.m. local time on Tuesday, September 21, 2010 and then publicly opened and read aloud.

The Bids permitted above shall be made only by filling in the blanks provided in the proposal. Any bid qualified by writing in any other way than specifically stated above will not be considered.

The Contractor shall perform a minimum of 50 percent of work by his own work forces unless specifically authorized by the Owner and Engineer and no Subcontractor shall be allowed to perform work on the project unless they are acceptable to the Owner and Engineer.

The Information for Bidders, Form of Bid, Form of Contract, Plans, Specifications, and Forms of Bid Bond, Performance and Payment Bonds, and other contract documents may be examined at the following: Polyengineering, Inc., (Engineer) located at 1935 Headland Avenue, Dothan, Alabama, 36303, or at the Office of the Purchasing Director at 208 North Partin Drive, Niceville, Florida, 32578. Copies may be obtained from Polyengineering, Inc., P. O. Box 837, Dothan, Alabama, 36302, upon payment of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each set.

Any unsuccessful bidder or any non-bidder upon returning such set in good condition within ten (10) days after Bid Opening will be refunded Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

A Bid Bond payable to The City of Niceville, Florida for an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid shall be filed with the proposal, the Bidders Bond being prepared on the forms specified and signed by a Bonding Company authorized to do business in the State of Florida.

The Contractor shall furnish a performance bond in an amount at least equal to 100% of the contract price as security for the faithful performance of this contract and also a payment bond in amount not less than 100% of the contract price or in a penal sum not less than that prescribed by State, territorial or local law, as security for the payment of all persons performing labor on the project under this contract and furnishing materials in connection with this contract. The performance bond and the payment bond may be in one or in separate instruments in accordance with local law but shall in all cases be prepared on the forms specified and signed by a Bonding Company authorized to do business in the State of Florida.

No plans or bidding documents will be issued within four (4) days of the bid opening.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within thirty-five (35)days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

All bidders must certify that he is aware of and agrees to abide by the Trench Safety Act of Florida, Chapter 90-96 of the Florida Statutes.

The award of this contract is subject to Chapter 112, Florida Statutes, which requires any bidder to declare any and all conflicts of interest.

All bids must be in sealed envelopes reflecting on the outside thereof "Bid for New Pump Station at City Hall to be opened at 2:00 p.m. local time on September 21, 2010".

There is no obligation on the part of the City of Niceville to award the bid. The City of Niceville reserves the right to reject all Bids, to reject non-conforming, non-responsive, non-responsible, unbalanced or conditional bids or to reject the Bid of any Bidder if the City of Niceville believes that it would not be in the best interest of the Project to make an award to that Bidder. The City reserves the right to waive any irregularity or technicality in Bids received. If the Bid is awarded, it will be awarded to the Bidder who submits the lowest responsible, responsive Bid which meets all the requirements in the Contract Documents. The City of Niceville shall be the sole judge of the Bid and its best interest and its decision shall be final.
