

CITY OF NICEVILLE PAINTBALL SAFETY RULES

- 1. Never shoot at any person or object outside the perimeter of the active playing field.**
- 2. Always wear approved goggles inside or near playing field. Not adhering to this rule is cause for immediate dismissal from the games.**
- 3. In goggle required areas, the goggle/mask may not be removed for any reason.**
- 4. Paintgun barrel blocking devices must be on with the barrel pointing to the ground while in staging, neutral, parking or any other non playing public areas.**
- 5. No physical confrontation between players, i.e. hand to hand combat, taking prisoners, etc. is permitted. Police will be alerted for any aggressive behavior.**
- 6. Never shoot at anyone who is not wearing approved eye protection or anyone whose safety gear is not in place.**
- 7. Never shoot at any player showing a neutrality symbol, surrendered player, judge, referee or spectator.**
- 8. No player may intentionally shoot at others players head or face. Repeat offenders will be out of the game the rest of the day.**
- 9. Never shoot at another player with anger or intent to cause harm. When within 15 feet, players are required to give opponent a chance to surrender.**
- 10. Do not shoot across neutral areas, staging areas or parking.**
- 11. Never look down the barrel to see if it's dirty. Squeegee the barrel or use fingers to check it.**
- 12. Never shoot anything from a paintgun except the water-soluble paintballs provided by the City of Niceville Youth Center.**
- 13. All paintguns must be chronographed prior to use in play and shall not exceed a velocity of 290 feet per second.**
- 14. Paintguns must not have a paintball or other projectile chambered while out of designated playing area.**
- 15. No discharging or dry firing of paintguns is allowed in any neutral or non playing area.**
- 16. Do not use a paintgun unless you have been versed on it's use and fully understand how to use it.**
