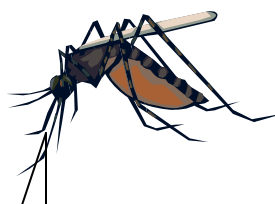

We've got some real “buggy” prizes for you this summer!

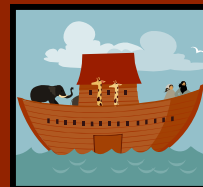
